

Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy discloses the privacy practices for this site and various related Services, including other websites, applications, forums, newsletters, and tools (together referred to as the “Services”). Please read the information below carefully.

Policy Changes

The Woodlands In Focus, (referred to as “us” or “we”) reserves the right to change this Privacy Policy at any time. Any changes, modifications, additions or deletions shall be effective immediately upon notice, which may be given by means including, but not limited to posting the revised Privacy Policy on this page. You acknowledge and agree that it is your responsibility to review this Privacy Policy periodically and to be aware of any modifications. Your continued use of the site after such modifications will constitute your: (a) acknowledgment of the modified Privacy Policy; and (b) agreement to abide and be bound by the modified Privacy Policy.

Types of Information Collected

We collect two types of information about our users: Non-Personally Identifiable Information and Personally Identifiable Information.

Non-Personally Identifiable Information: When users use the Services, we collect and aggregate information indicating, among other things, which pages were visited, the order in which they were visited, and which links were "clicked." Collecting such information involves the logging of IP addresses, operating system, and browser software used by each user of the Services. Although such information is not personally identifiable, we can determine from the IP address a user’s internet service provider and the geographic location of the user’s point of connectivity.

The non-personally identifiable information we collect helps us identify the most popular areas of our Services and determine the effectiveness of our marketing activities. We collect non-personally identifiable information in part through the use of small text files (“cookies”) placed on your computer's hard drive that help us determine the type of content and pages to which you link, the length of time you spend at any particular area of the Services, and the Services you choose to use.

Personally Identifiable Information: In certain areas of the Services, we may request that you provide us with certain Personally Identifiable Information. Personally Identifiable Information includes, among other things, your e-mail address, name, zip code, profession, or work experience. We will, in such situations, seek to identify which informational items are mandatory and which are optional. If you do not provide the mandatory information with respect to a particular activity, you will not be able to engage in that activity. The Woodlands In Focus will not collect any personal information from you unless you provide it to us voluntarily.

Collection Methods and Use of Information

The Woodlands In Focus encourages all third parties involved to adhere to our policies regarding the privacy of our users and to otherwise handle Personally Identifiable Information in a responsible manner. We cooperate with law enforcement agencies in identifying those who may be using our servers or Services for illegal activities. We also reserve the right to report any suspected illegal activity to law enforcement for investigation or prosecution, or to suspend or terminate your account in connection with any suspected illegal or infringing activity or if you are in violation of our Terms of Use Agreement or other published guidelines.

If The Woodlands In Focus is involved in a merger, acquisition, or sale of all or a portion of its assets, you will be notified via email and/or a prominent notice on our Services of any change in ownership or uses of your Personally Identifiable Information, as well as any choices you may have regarding your Personally Identifiable Information.
